









“How to play a DVD (video) from your computer!”

(Note: Audio levels can be controlled by CD/MP3 on audio enhancement)


1) Place DVD in your computer drive	
2) Double Click on “Computer” icon on desktop.	
3) Locate “Devices with Removable Storage” and DVD Drive icon.	
<p>4) Right Click on DVD Drive, select “Play with VLC media player”</p> <p>Note: If you do not see the above message, please skip to pages 2-4 of this document for an alternative method to reach the VLC player.</p>	

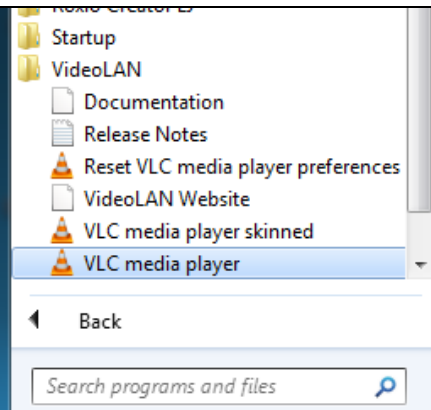
5) VLC Player will open the DVD from your drive. Controls are at bottom of screen. “Hover” mouse over icons for descriptions if needed.

<p>4) Scroll through alphabetical file list and select</p>  VideoLAN	

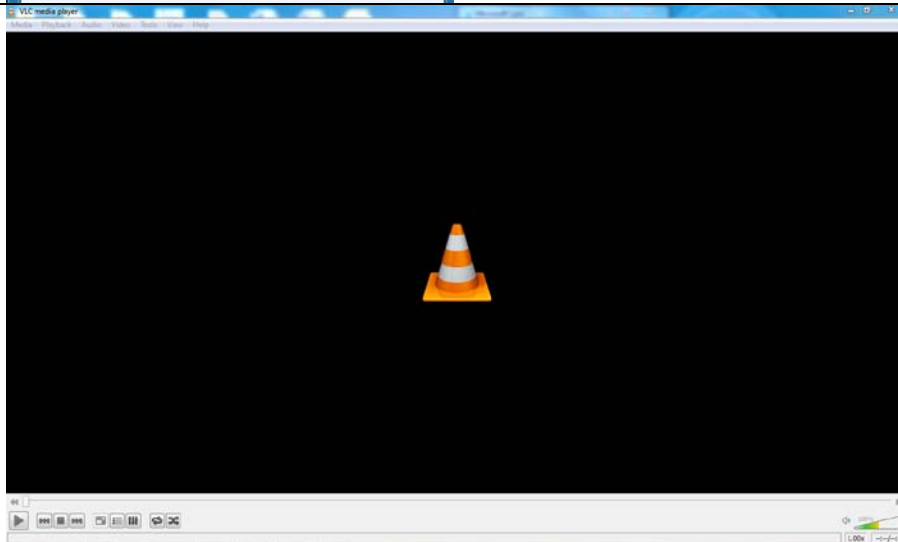
5) Select

 VLC media play



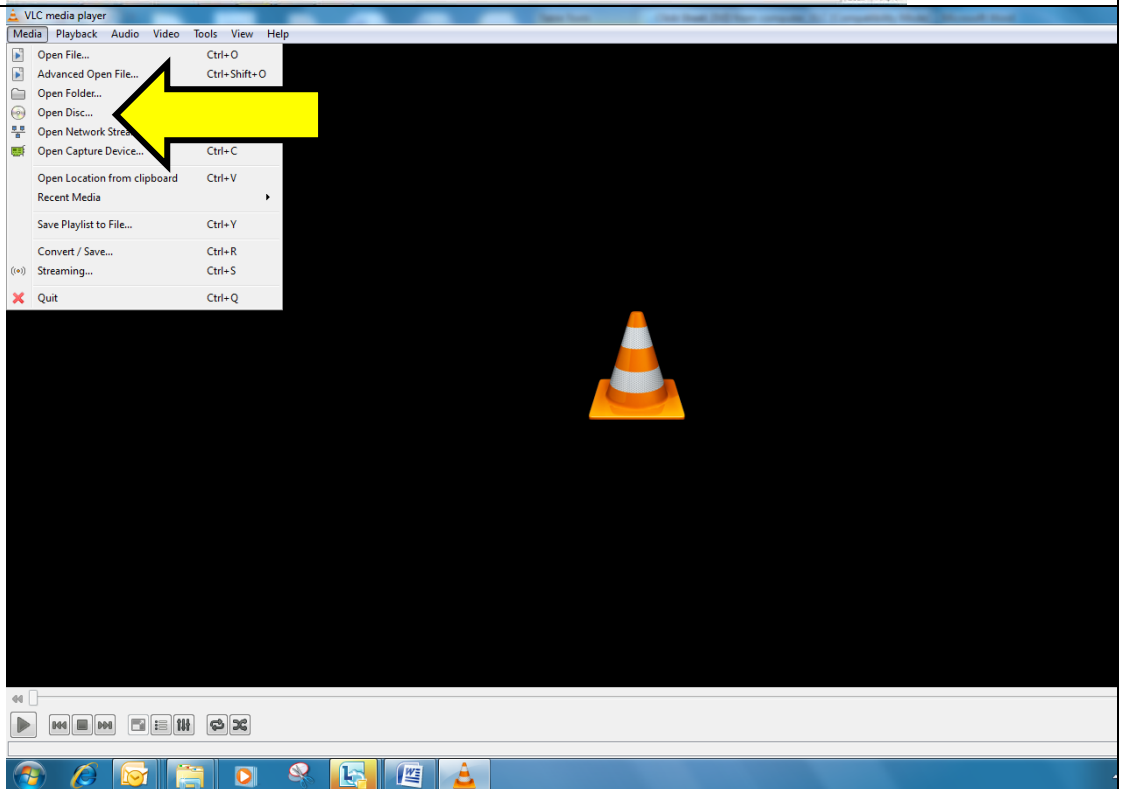
VLC Player will open.

Note: You might have to maximize your screen to see the entire VLC player.!

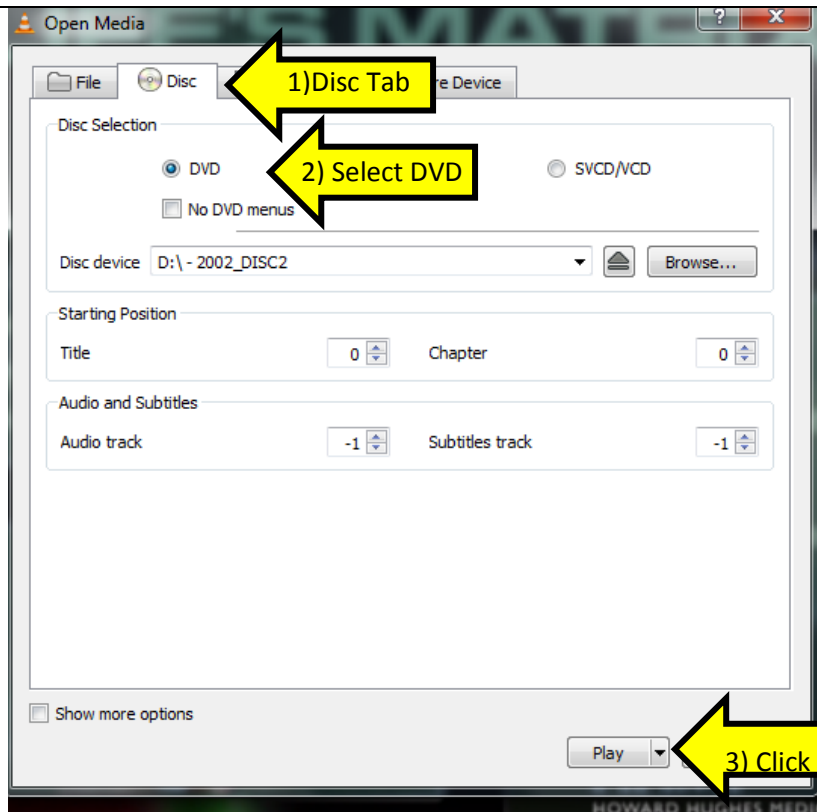


Click Media on Tool Bar
